Emphasis on retiring service personnel from army, navy and air force personnel was conveyed 4. MOU must be signed with respective line Directorates 5. All courses run by DGR will be immediately aligned with the existing QP's 6. Domain training of TOA/TOT will be carried out in the respective SSC certified Stand Alone centers 7. Platform Skills may be acquired at any of the designated TOT/TOA centers irrespective of the SSC 8. 6	ABOUT THE EVENT/ ACTIVITY (in max 200 words)	<p>CEO & COO attended the meeting called by the JS, MSDE to identify areas which need to be amended in PSARA so far as training is concerned.</p> <p>CEO, SSSDC raised points during deliberations for consideration of the august gathering are as follows: -</p> <p>a. Recognition of SSSDC Certification by State Controlling Authorities: In the manner by which MSDE/NSDC have been made the sole responsibility of skilling in the country by the Government, likewise SSSDC has been nominated as the authorized Skilling Body to impart training conduct, conduct assessments & carry out certification in the domain of Private Security. This aspect not being recognized by the State Controlling Authorities. This anomaly needs to be resolved at the</p>

		<p>earliest. Detailed proposal to be taken up with the Ministry of Home Affairs has already been forwarded to the JS, MSDE for initiating a case recommending MHA to issue directions to the State Controlling Authorities to grant recognition to the SSSDC affiliated Training Centres after due diligence & also recognize the certification issued by SSSDC. This needs to be expedited.</p> <p>b. Training Model for Entrepreneurs: There is a need to formulate business centric approach in the skilling domain. SSSDC should endeavor to create suitable Job Roles for Entrepreneurs corresponding to various levels & requirements in the Industry.</p> <p>c. DGR Sponsored Training: It was clarified by the CEO, SSSDC that in accordance with the latest orders, all training being sponsored by DGR have to be structured in accordance with the NOSs & should be vetted by SSSDC before the course can be conducted in any Training Centre.</p> <p>d. Exemption to Owners of PSAs with large turn over. On the request put forth by IISM, it was clarified that no exemptions can be granted on such pretext. Training rules & modalities have to be followed by all, irrespective of stature.</p>
