6	ABOUT THE EVENT/ ACTIVITY (in max 200 words)	<p>Steering Committee meeting was held at SSSDC office on 21 Nov 2017 attended by the Chairman, Shri. Mahesh Sharma, Shri. Sanjeev Paul and CEO.</p> <p>Following points were discussed during the meeting:</p> <p>Chairman explained the series of events to the Steering Committee and specifically about the performance audit and SSSDC's response to the Show Cause Notice sent by MSDE for Financial irregularities in the utilization of various amount allocated to SSSDC. He also briefed about his meeting with the JS, MSDE.</p> <p>CEO apprised the Steering Committee Members that QP on Fireman has been fielded for QRC approval.</p> <p>On cost of printing of certificates, it was suggested to explore ways to issue certificates online to save the printing cost</p> <p>CEO presented the proposal to condense the time frame for dues of AB's and presented two proposals 1. 90 days and 2. 45 days. It was decided that repeatedly erring ABs together with the written notices to be forwarded to Chairman. After lot of deliberations, an important decision to support the AB's by paying all their dues beyond 90 days was approved by the Committee Members. However, proposal to appoint new AB's was put down by the Committee for the time being and it was suggested to report their failures and non-performance in writing to them to put the records straight.</p> <p>SSSDC role at the 12<sup>th</sup> Security, Skills and Leadership Summit was discussed. Since the core subject of the Conference is Skilling, Chairman suggested that SSSDC become Knowledge Partners at the Summit. This will entitle SSSDC apart from the usual sponsorship benefits, complimentary entry for all its associated Trainers and Assessors to the Summit. As a special gesture Chairman said that Registration charges will be waived off for Trainers, Assessors and Army Trainees (that</p>

		<p>were through DIAV) and will also be provided Lunch and Tea/Snacks during the Summit at no cost to individual or SSSDC.</p> <p>Thoughts on creation of Centres of Excellence were presented to the Steering Committee and it was decided to outsource the preparation of draft project report to competent agencies for preparation. Mr. Mahesh Sharma to introduce the suitable Agency to SSSDC.</p> <p>CEO explained that the placement platform of SSSDC is being examined to enhance the placement and an app is being explored which can connect the job seeker to the industry. If approved this will be included in the Business Model. This coupled with industry connect will ensure better placements &amp; consequent pay-outs.</p> <p>Another point that came up for discussion was the validation of SSSDC certification by Controlling Authorities. It was suggested to send a letter to all Controlling Authorities explaining the parameters being used to accredit and affiliate Training Centres and to suggest that controlling authority may affiliate these centres with the authority for Training and Certification.</p>

Hydro Carbon SSC has been added as the 41<sup>st</sup> SSC with Mr. Roy as the CEO.</li> <li>2. SSC's to review the Business Plan 2017-18 particularly with regard to achievement of targets in Q1 &amp; Q2.</li> <li>3. Aggregation of Jobs – Demand aggregation to be revisited – Region wise, Job wise and Company wise.</li> <li>4. Assessment procedure to be reviewed keeping a stringent check on the integrity of Assessors.</li> <li>5. Enhance State Engagements</li> <li>6. Sharda Prasad Committee – No. of SSC's likely to be brought down to 31.</li> </ol> <p><b><u>Ms. Ritu Agarwal</u></b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Special emphasis was given on Overseas Placements. Within the next one year, 3 lakh trained personnels with various job roles are likely to proceed to Japan. (Knowledge of Japanese language is mandatory).</li> <li>2. SSC's advised to carry out Global Skill Gap Study.</li> </ol> <p><b><u>Mr. Rajiv Mathur</u></b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Role of Private Universities to contribute financially to the SSC's ecosystem.</li> <li>2. Setting up Skills Universities</li> </ol> <p><b><u>RPL by Mr. Mahendra Singh Payaal</u></b> He covered the following:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Managing RPL projects with regards to imparting of Training.</li> <li>2. Ensure timely assessments.</li> </ol> <p><b><u>Mr. Rajesh Agrawal, IAS</u></b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1.
